

ICE DANCERS

In stark contrast to the almost-snowless Monte Carlo Historique just 300 miles away, Italy's Winter Challenge suffered heavy snow, handing the advantage to light, nimble Lancias that took six of the top ten places on the leaderboard. Giuliano Cané and Lucia Galliani took their sixth win on the event in their 1938 Aprilia (pictured), beating the second-placed 1939 Aprilia of Ezio and Francesca Salviato by 39 penalty points. The 1965 Morris Cooper S of Antonino Margiotta and Bruno Perno got the final podium spot, while the 12th-placed 1967 Innocenti Cooper of Andrea Belometti and Stefano Cadei secured the inaugural APT Trophy for their efforts on the frozen lake stage at Madonna di Campiglio.
