Fiats dominate in the Italian snow

After having to settle for second place in 2020, Edoardo Bellini and Roberto Tiberti went one better on this year's Winter Marathon from 14-17 January. The win followed their fourth victory on the rally's sister challenge, the Franciacorta Historic, last August.

It was a one-two for 1937 Fiat 508Cs, with second clinched by Alberto Aliverti and Stefano Valente. Completing the podium

was another Fiat, Fabio and Marco Salvinelli's 1954 1100/103.

The 33rd running of the event based in Madonna di Campiglio was tough for competitors and organisers alike, with some passes closed just a day before due to high winds and snowfall. Double World Rally Champion Miki Biasion, co-driven by Paola Ramella Paia in an Alfa Romeo 1750GTV, finished 62nd, while former racing

driver turned television presenter Davide Valsecchi came home 44th with Gabriele Francesco Ricco in a Fiat 124 Abarth Rally.

On 16 January there were two contests held on the frozen lake. Giovanni Pighi and Luigi Callegari (356B Roadster) were fastest and scooped the prize for top Porsche, while Massimo Bisi and Claudio Cattivelli (356B) were the fifth winners of the Eberhard Trophy.
